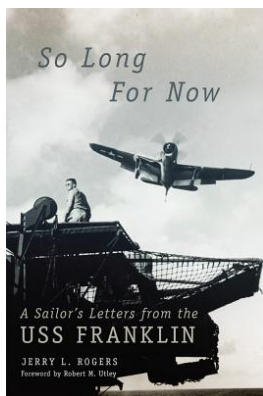

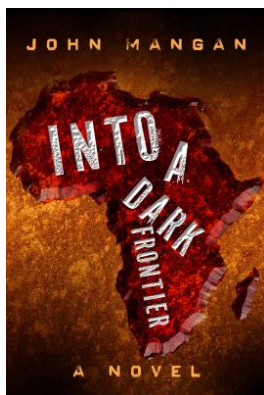

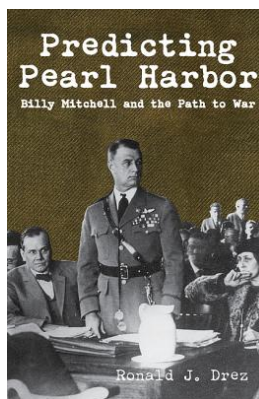
JERRY L. ROGERS
